

Dear Parent/Guardians,

We are extremely excited to be able to start our **Academic School Year 2020 / 2021** on school premises! We know that on-line teaching has been a challenge for all of us but with all groups and school phases, from Primary to Exam Years, we managed to gain some positives out of these difficult times.

SAIS is well aware of the resilience we will be facing when we come back in full force and we have prepared accordingly. We would like to draw your attention to the seven points below and remind our community that all is being updated on a daily basis as we are all taking THIS NEW REALITY INTO ACCOUNT. things on a daily basis.

- (a) Restart after pandemic As always SAIS will stagger its different school phases (Primary P2-P4; Middle School A1-A4 and Upper End A5 A8) when it comes to their first day back. In this light all <u>Primary</u> pupils will join us first on <u>Monday the 31st of August</u> as of 8 o'clock. <u>Middle school</u> will join on <u>Tuesday 1st September</u> and finally our <u>Upper</u> end will start on <u>Wednesday 2nd of September</u>.
- (b) Physical and on-line teaching All lessons will progress 'as normal' physically inside our classrooms/Labs/Gym areas. All windows and doors will be open at all times to promote natural ventilation/ air renewal. We will stagger breaks/lessons/lunchtimes so as to minimize congestion in popular areas such as the crush-hall. As for on-line teaching, SAIS will keep our Microsoft Teams platform and continue to enhance our academic programs and centralise data/knowledge – however we will not stream lessons as the norm.
- (c) Examinations & Exam Years This has truly been a stamina trial for these SAIS Pupils. Please be advised that we will continue to work towards exceptional exam results and that the October/November Series will run as usual. (Please inform your tutors of any extra re-takes or first time enrolments on CIE Direct).

The Chess Sporting Directors will meet on the 26th of August for more details. As for fieldtrips, SAIS will privilege outdoors events and no public transport.

You will notice that the whole school has new signage in the light of Covid procedures. The circulation around the school building must abide by the arrows of the various routes. As for lunch periods inside the Dining room, these have been staggered, separated seating and internal circuits for moving about have been defined. All these need to be complied with. As for Parents and visitors, the school is not yet allowing parents in as this whole situation is new for all our community. The paramount objective is to maintain social distancing and not promote groups gathering.
